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At Sacred Heart Academy of Pasig (SHAP), safety always comes first. The school believes that being prepared can make all the difference during an emergency. That’s why SHAP holds emergency training conferences to ensure that teachers and staff know exactly what to do in times of crisis.



During the training, teachers, staff, and administrators each play an active role in learning and practicing emergency procedures. From responding to earthquakes and fires to assisting during evacuations.



To be precise and professional, the **Pasig City DRRMO Fire Rescue Section** visits the campus to conduct demonstrations and educate the SHAP staff on proper emergency response. These sessions give everyone firsthand experience in using fire extinguishers, handling rescue procedures, practicing and coordinating with local emergency teams.



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The training also includes earthquake and typhoon preparedness, where staff learn how to respond quickly and guide students to safety during natural disasters. SHAP emphasizes earthquake drills, safe evacuation routes, and post-earthquake procedures, as well as protocols for heavy rain and flooding scenarios. Teachers are trained to manage classrooms safely during sudden weather changes, secure learning areas, and assist in implementing the school's typhoon safety measures.



Through these ongoing efforts, SHAP continues to build a community that is alert, responsible, and ready, because the **safety of every student and staff member will always be the school's top priority.**

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In the first aid training that involved various techniques, **Mr. Jose Marie M. Galang** from **Red Cross** demonstrated the first aid training techniques; he particularly showed both non-teaching staff and teaching staff how to properly triangular bandage the forehead, arms, legs, and thighs while explaining the importance of first aid.




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Mr. Galang as well as his assistant **Mr. John Gabriel D. Mallilin** also demonstrated hands-only CPR correctly and what to do when you encounter a person choking. Including examples of different types of situations if the person choking were pregnant, such as safely applying pressure to the sternum.



SHAP conducted this seminar in case of similar situations or if an emergency were to occur involving this. The benefits of learning these first aid techniques can help save someone's life during an emergency and can prevent worse scenarios after with proper procedures in first aid. This is to ensure the safety of those around us, having been educated about the topic and being able to perform the procedures if necessary.
